

Minutes of the February 18, 2020 EVQG Meeting

Donna opened the meeting with some phrases we have all heard, giving the origins of the phrases. She announced that the next meeting will be at the Goodyear Building due to elections using the Civic Center.

Rita Jensen introduced the speaker, Gretchen Hudock, who gave a presentation on organizing our rooms, including our quilting space. The program next month will be given by Tara Miller on The Quilt District.

There were several announcements of quilt-related events in the general area.

Diana Zuspahn gave updated information on the Mystery quilt which can be done in 4 sizes. Information is on the website. She also showed many of the tree blocks that had been turned in to be sent to Australia. These will be used by Australian quilters to make quilts for those affected by the fire.

Jan Shepherd announced that the February Creative Stitchery class is full. In March, Judy Smith will be teaching the Cathedral Window quilt. The April class, taught by Teresa Cook, is on making an art quilt.

Wanda Richardson reminded members about the Challenge quilt guidelines. The quilt is due at the June meeting.

There is no change in Bee information.

Tammy Bennett will be collecting large lap or twin sized quilts to be donated to Flowery Branch Children's home for those that are "graduating" from the program. This is not an official guild project, but those who would like to may turn these in to Tammy.

The Greater Atlanta Shop Hope is later this year with a date of May 27-29.

The guild is reminded of the upcoming quilt show this year. The show is October 1-3 with setup on September 29-30. All members are encouraged to enter one or more quilts and to sign up in upcoming months for specific jobs during the show. More information will be coming with signup lists for various jobs.
